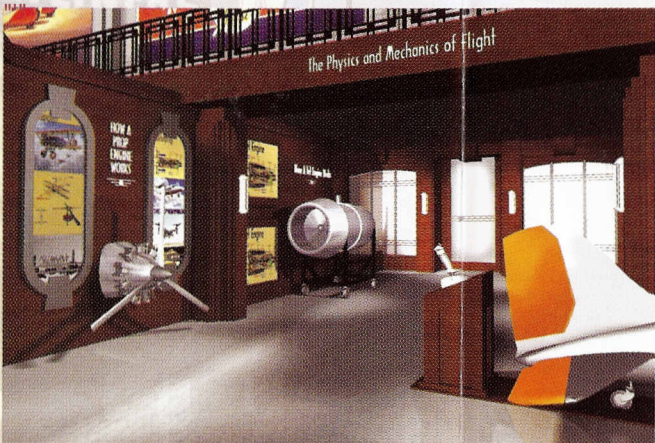


by becoming the definitive national museum for the commercial airline industry.

It's astounding, but did you know that an industry with nearly 100 years of history, that captured the world's attention as airlines were birthed, merged and died, and has grown to become the preferred mode of transportation does not have a dedicated national museum?

In 2002 a group of retired airline employees and civic leaders met to discuss creating a lasting legacy to the commercial airlines that helped make Atlanta home to the busiest airport in the world. From this first conversation a national movement was born, resulting in the National Museum of Commercial Aviation (NMCA).



A collaborative effort between the non-profit 501 (c)3 museum and business, aviation and com-

munity partners throughout the country, the Museum will be located off Interstate 75, near Hartsfield-Jackson Atlanta International Airport.

This will be the only museum to feature all aspects of airlines and airport operations, from cargo to passengers. Interactive exhibits, simulators, real aircraft, theater area and a major research library and archival department will help to achieve the museum's broad mission.

Travel back to a gentler time, when passengers travelled in their Sunday best. Learn about advances in aircraft design, experience different eras of air travel, board actual aircraft, sit in real cockpits, view advertising memorabilia, serving ware and uniforms, and the ground equipment that helps make it all happen.

The museum expects to break ground in 2009, and open to the public in 2010, but we can't do it without your help. An \$8-million fundraising campaign has been launched to provide the necessary capital to design, construct and open the first phase of the museum.

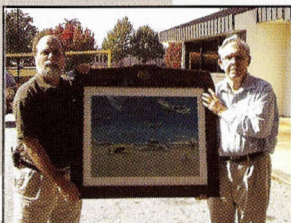
